ELIGIBILITY

To qualify for VETS RESTORE you must:

- Be a veteran of active duty with an honorable, medical, general or under honorable conditions discharge, or be a National Guard or Reservist that has met their initial service obligation
- Be a resident of King County
- Priority will be given to post 9/11 veterans but all veterans are welcome to apply
